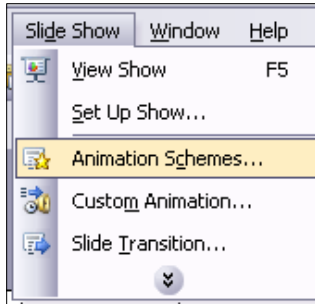


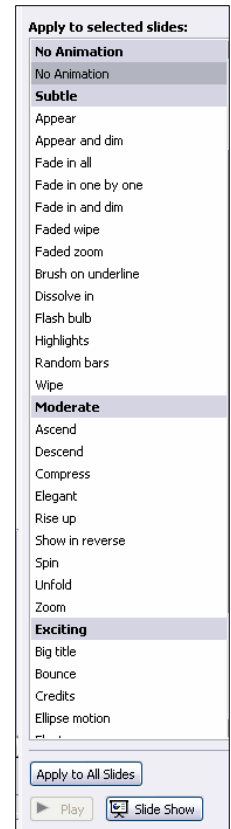
## Animating Your Slides /Adding Effects in PowerPoint

After creating your PowerPoint slides, you can have your bullets appear one at a time as you click. You can do this in two ways.

### Option 1 – This option will add animations to all of your slides

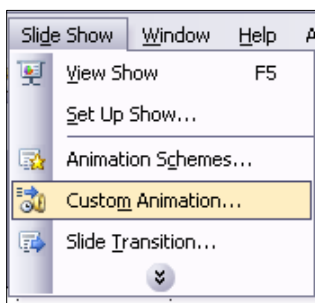


- Click on **Slide Show** and **Animation Schemes**
- Then, click on an animation from the Slide Design at the right of your screen
  - Click on an animation to see a preview
- Once you have selected an animation, click **Apply to All Slides**



### Option 2 – This option will allow you to add different animations to different slides or choose which slides have animations

- Click on the slide to which you want to add animations



- Click on **Slide Show** and **Custom Animation**
- Make sure the text box you want to add animations to is selected by clicking on it
- On the right side of your screen in the Custom Animation box click **Add Effect, Entrance**, and then choose the effect you would like. Click on **More Effects...** for more choices
  - By clicking on an effect, you will be able to preview it

- Click **OK** once you have chosen an effect
