



## Academic Annual Copyright License from Copyright Clearance Center

It is important that Hofstra faculty and staff follow Hofstra University policy for use of copyrighted material for any reading being scanned or copied and provided to students. To facilitate this process, Hofstra University subscribes to the Academic Annual Copyright License (ACL) from the Copyright Clearance Center (CCC). This license provides faculty, librarians, research and administrative staff with comprehensive, institution-wide coverage for the reuse of text-based content in both print and electronic formats for educational and research purposes. There are over a million titles included in the license repertory, and this list continues to grow.

Types of use covered under the license include:

- Library reserves (print and electronic)
- Blackboard postings
- Classroom handouts
- Coursepacks (print and electronic)

Types of use not covered under the license include:

- Interlibrary loan (ILL)
- Non-educational uses (e.g., promotional and advertising)
- Copyrighted material covered by the CCC Annual Copyright License, but subject to individual publisher restrictions as noted in the license.

Library assistance is available at all steps of the process of determining whether a use is licensed. When you find a publication that is not covered by the license, you have several options for reproducing the material in compliance with University policy. If the material is from a database licensed by Hofstra University, refer to the Guide to Linking to Articles. In some instances the library can secure and pay for copyright clearance for you to use materials; contact Sarah McCleskey, Head of Access Services, at 516-463-5076 or [Sarah.E.McCleskey@hofstra.edu](mailto:Sarah.E.McCleskey@hofstra.edu) for assistance. If the amount of material you need exceeds what the library can pay for, you can contact the Hofstra University Bookstore for assistance in compiling a print coursepack through the [Xanedu](http://www.xanedu.com/reference/General%20Brochure_X2854.pdf) service at [http://www.xanedu.com/reference/General%20Brochure\\_X2854.pdf](http://www.xanedu.com/reference/General%20Brochure_X2854.pdf).

Coursepacks usually take 3-6 weeks from start to finish; copyright fees are included in the cost of the coursepack.

This will take you to a search screen for materials covered by the ACL. You can search by Publication Title or ISBN/ISSN and/or Publisher. In the example below, the professor searched for the title *Handbook of Interpersonal Communication*. Once you have entered the publication title, click "Search." Note: When searching by title, enter the Publication Title, not the title of the article or chapter. Eliminate initial articles (*a*, *an*, or *the*).
