Actor

The Edward Lynch Collection in the Hofstra University Archives Consists of playbills, scripts, personal correspondence, photographs and memorabilia. Mr. Lynch was a 1956 graduate of Hofstra, and while at Hofstra acted as President of the Green Wig and starred in several campus plays. Mr. Lynch was involved in productions of the Annual Shakespeare Festival at Hofstra, including, 'Much Ado About Nothing' and 'King Richard III.'

Mr. Lynch continued his acting career and starred in off Broadway plays, such as 'Macbeth', 'Romeo and Juliet,' and 'Two Gentlemen From Verona', during the Summer Shakespeare Festival in Central Park. In addition to appearing on radio and television, Mr. Lynch also starred in such productions as 'Mrs. Moses', 'Sweet William', 'Waiting for Godot', 'The Recruiting Officer', and 'As You Like It.'
