and Margret Rayner. all the remaining part of my household furniture equa-  
ly to be divided share and share alike I give to my Grandson Samuel Smith the Sum of Ten  
Pounds. I give and bequeath unto my five Sons Ezekiel Rayner Lester Rayner Benjamin  
Rayner Manzie Rayner and Mordeiah Rayner respectively and to their heirs and  
assigns all the remaining part of my Estate Real and Personal with all my rights in  
in Common in the Township of Hempstead equally to be divided share and share  
alike The Place to be sold if they shall judge it best. Lastly I constitute or dain  
and appoint my five Sons Ezekiel Rayner Lester Rayner Benjamin Rayner Man-  
zie Rayner and Mordeiah Rayner Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Ra-  
tifying allowing and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament
