2002-03: Missed the season due to a wrist injury...Received medical red-shirt.

2001-02: Played in all 28 games, starting three...Averaged 5.7 points and a team-high 5.2 rebounds per game...Led team in blocked shots with 32...Ranked fourth on the team in scoring...Ranked 18th in the Colonial Athletic Association in rebounding and fourth in blocks...Scored a career-high 15 points and grabbed nine rebounds versus William & Mary...Had 14 points and seven rebounds in regular season finale against Delaware...Posted a double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds at UNC

Wilmington...Had 12 points versus William & Mary in CAA Tournament game...Grabbed 10 rebounds in home game versus UNC Wilmington...Pulled down nine boards versus Monmouth...Had three blocks versus Monmouth and William & Mary, and at Old Dominion and UNC Wilmington...Recorded three steals versus Pennsylvania and at Army and Old Dominion...Averaged 6.3 points and 5.5 rebounds per game in conference play...Averaged 22.9 minutes per contest.

2000-01: Appeared in 21 games, starting seven...Averaged 4.6 points and 4.2 rebounds per game...Shot .439 from the field...Scored 14 points and grabbed five rebounds versus Towson...Had 12 points and nine rebounds versus Albany...Scored nine points against Columbia...Pulled down a career-best 13 rebounds at Monmouth...Had eight boards versus Charleston Southern...Blocked two shots against Columbia, Drexel and Northeastern...Had three steals at Monmouth...Recorded two steals versus Columbia and at Towson...Averaged 3.9 points and 3.3 rebounds per game in America East action...Averaged 18.4 minutes per game.

1999-00: Played in 26 games...Averaged 3.3 points and 2.9 rebounds per game...Had a season-high 11 points in back-to-back games against Hartford and Vermont...Recorded nine points versus Yale...Tallied seven points at Boston University...Grabbed nine rebounds versus Boston University...Recorded eight rebounds at Drexel...Had six rebounds versus Delaware and Hartford...Had two steals against Maine and at Drexel...Blocked two shots versus Delaware...Averaged 3.3 points and 3.4 rebounds in America East games...Averaged 12.1 minutes per game.

Came to Hofstra from Sparta High School in Sparta, New Jersey...Played basketball for four years, softball for two years and tennis for two years at Sparta...Helped lead her team to the league, county and sectional championships as a freshman...Named Most Valuable Player at county tournament as a freshman...Received first team all-league honors and was named all-area honorable mention as a sophomore after helping her team to the sectional championship...As a junior, team won league, county and sectional championships...Received all-league, all-area, all-tournament, All-West Jersey and third-team All-New Jersey Group 3 honors as a junior...AAU team participated in the AAU Basketball National Championships in Shreveport, Louisiana, in 1997 and Indianapolis, Indiana, in 1998...Named to the Academic Honor Roll as a senior...Averaged 15 points and 10 rebounds per game as a junior...Also shot 84 percent from the free throw line, recorded 132 blocked shots and hit a school-record 62 three-pointers on the year...Has one brother and one sister...Enjoys mountain biking and playing beach volleyball in her free time...Was a D.A.R.E. role model, high school peer group leader and a Sparta Township volunteer camp counselor...Aspires to work in the sports marketing field after graduation...Born May 30, 1981...Fine arts major...Marketing minor.
