**Joanna L. Grossman** is Professor and Associate Dean for Faculty Development at Hofstra Law School. She has also taught at Tulane Law School, the University of North Carolina School of Law, and Cardozo Law School. She graduated with distinction from Stanford Law School and served as a law clerk to Judge William A. Norris of the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. Professor Grossman has published articles on sexual harassment, work/family issues, sex discrimination in employment, state regulation of marriage, and the history of family law in the *Stanford Law Review*, *Harvard Women's Law Journal*, and the *American Journal of Legal History*, among other journals. She is a regular columnist for *FindLaw's Writ* and has served on the editorial board of *Perspectives*, the magazine of the ABA's Commission on Women in the Profession. Recently, she co-authored an amicus brief on behalf of women's groups in *Ledbetter v. Goodyear Tire and Rubber*, a case in which the Supreme Court considered how to apply Title VII's statute of limitations to pay discrimination claims.
