Dear Applicant:

The Stephen B. Carlin/Walter W. Rudolph Endowed Memorial Scholarship was established in 1986 by family and friends of Hofstra alumni Stephen Carlin and Walter Rudolph. Those senior high school students who have been accepted to Hofstra University and meet the following requirements are eligible to apply:

- The applicant is a direct descendent of an honorably-discharged "in country" Vietnam War veteran of the U.S. Military Services, or
- The applicant is, or is the direct descendent of, an honorably discharged veteran of the U.S Military Services with "in-country" service in Afghanistan or Iraq since 1991, or
- The applicant is, or is a direct descendent of, an honorably-discharged veteran of the U.S. Military Services, and
- The applicant has demonstrated outstanding academic, co-curricular and community involvement, and/or financial need.

Scholarships are awarded to one or more matriculated students at Hofstra University. Recipients must remain in good standing while at the University. The scholarship is awarded by the Hofstra University Office of Financial Aid upon the recommendation of the Carlin/Rudolph Scholarship Committee.

For consideration, the applicant must already be accepted to Hofstra University, and submit a completed application and include the following items:

A copy of your current high school or college transcript or DAR (if current Hofstra student); FERPA Student Release; Form DD214 (for the applicant or the applicant's Veteran relative); and typewritten Personal Statement.

A consent form, FERPA Student Release, must be submitted along with this application. The FERPA form can be obtained from the Student Administrative Complex in Memorial Hall, or downloaded from Hofstra's Website at www.hofstra.edu/pdf/acadrec_FERPA.pdf.
