- FERPA

- Current Hofstra University transcript

Applications must be legibly written, word processed or typed. Please send your application along with a copy of a high school transcript, college transcript (if transfer student) or Degree Audit Report (DAR) if current Hofstra student; two letters of recommendation; and a completed FERPA form, which can be found at: www.hofstra.edu/pdf/acadrec_FERPA.pdf.
