THE HOFSTRA UNIVERSITY MUSEUM:

- ▶ Was founded in 1963.
- ▶ Is accredited by the American Association of Museums (AAM).
- ▶ Has a permanent collection of approximately 5,000 works of art in varied media dating from the ancient to the contemporary, and includes American artists of the 19th and 20th centuries.
- ▶ Is open year-round to the public with free admission.
- ▶ Is composed of two wheelchair-accessible galleries, Emily Lowe Gallery located behind Emily Lowe Hall, and David Filderman Gallery located on the ninth floor of the Joan and Donald E. Axinn Library.
- ▶ Has an outdoor sculpture collection that includes approximately 70 pieces placed throughout Hofstra's 240-acre campus.




