Action research, also called classroom research or teacher research, is a term used to describe professionals studying their own practice in order to improve it. Applied to teaching, it involves gathering and interpreting data to better understand an aspect of teaching practice that interests or concerns you. This workshop is designed to facilitate a process that engages you in your own professional development in your own classroom, allowing you to seek answers to your own questions.

Workshop is held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on four Saturdays with additional interaction electronically – 2/2/08, 3/1/08, 4/5/08 and 4/12/08.

Participants must attend all four sessions.
