## **Geology for Elementary School Teachers: A Field Trip to Garvies Point: A Resource for K-12 Teachers**

The Garvies Point Preserve is home to Nassau County's museum of regional geology, archeology, and natural history, set among hills and cliffs that provide an excellent outdoor laboratory for studying the glacial geology of Long Island. The program will begin with an introduction to the geologic history and features of Long Island, many of which we will see as we travel north from Hofstra to Glen Cove.

After touring the museum we will explore the grounds of the preserve and discuss the formation and geologic history of Long Island.
