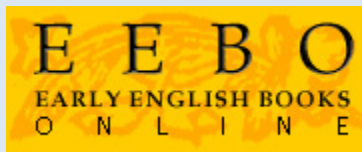




Early English Books Online Research Database



Dear Subscriber,

Early English Books Online will include facsimiles of nearly every known book printed in England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, and British North America from 1473-1700. It now includes approximately 107,000 of the 125,000 books expected to be available upon completion. A fuller description of this collection is available here:

Among the innovative features of the EEBO platform is the capability to return search results with all variant spellings of words by simply checking a box. Page images are available as TIFFs and PDFs and can be downloaded and manipulated with readily available software. Durable URLs leading to individual page images are also supported. Citations can be formulated and downloaded into a variety of citation management programs.

EEBO should be a valuable addition to the Library's database offerings and support the curriculum in literature, history, philosophy, and religion.
