United States Serial Set

The U.S. Serial Set is a full text collection of official government publications in searchable PDF format. It is considered one of the most important sets of primary source documents for the study of U.S. history. The digital collection begins in 1789 and continues through 1969 and contains detailed information on a wide variety of subjects. The collection includes congressional reports on legislation, reports from congressional committee investigations, annual reports from Federal executive agencies, extended series of survey, research and statistical publications from executive agencies and maps and illustrations.

Congressional Hearings Digital Collection

The Congressional Hearings Digital Collection provides full text access to congressional committee hearings from 1824 to 2003 in searchable PDF format. Hearings are the most requested of all government information and enable the researcher to discover how public policy is made. Congressional committees considering legislation hold hearings in order to gather information that will inform their decision making. Hearings often contain written and oral statements of witnesses, transcripts of dialogue between committee members and witnesses and reports, exhibits and other material submitted by witnesses and other interested parties.
