


The University Library provides Students and Faculty with access to over 35,000 journals!

Dear Subscriber,

The University Library provides Hofstra students and faculty with access to over 35,000 journals. Some of these journals are library subscriptions but many more are available through the databases the library licenses. It would be nearly impossible to find out which database contains which journal on a case by case basis, but there is a service that does the work for you called Journal Finder.

A link to Journal Finder, a service of Serials Solutions, can be found on the Library's home page under the heading Finding Information. The most common way to search Journal Finder is by journal title. A search for the journal *Political Science Quarterly* would yield the following:

The information includes year of coverage and a link to the database where full text can be found.

Another way to search is by subject. Although the subjects are broad and the results are quite large, there is some further subcategory breakdown on the results page. A subject search might be a way to discover useful journals that are available electronically with which you are not familiar.
