Dear Subscriber,

The Hofstra University Library's latest journal package comes from the publisher Springer. It contains over 1,750 full text electronic journals accessible via their computer platform (SpringerLink). The collection is interdisciplinary with particular strengths in science, technology, and math (STM). About 1/3 of the journals are in other disciplines. Coverage generally goes back to 1997.

The SpringerLink platform also contains over 40,000 books. A basic search will include this material, but please be aware that most of these books will not be available in full text to Hofstra users. Therefore, it is advisable to only search journals. To do this, use the Advanced Search link next to the initial search window. Choose "Journals Only" from the drop-down window (under the Category and Date Limiters heading).

SpringerLink supports the usual range of personalization features such as alerts, saved searches, and RSS feeds. A simple registration is required to take advantage of these features.

Best of all, this acquisition is a true "sweetheart" deal with only a modest increase of \$500 in subscription costs. Our long-standing subscription relationship with Springer, combined with membership in a new library cooperative organization (LyraSis), made this possible.
