## Need a primary source for a period before the New York Times was around? Try the other Times.

Dear Subscriber,

The Times (London) Digital Archive contains the full text of the newspaper from its inception in 1785 through 1985. The facsimile pages include every word as it originally appeared including the advertisements. Keyword searches can be qualified by date, by the part of the article in which the word appeared (author, title, text, etc.), or by section of the newspaper in which the word appeared. The pdf page image can be displayed in several ways and the full range of pdf image manipulation tools are available. Articles can be printed and a citation to the article can be emailed.
