

Submitting Theses & Dissertations

Students have two options for submitting their Master's Thesis & Doctoral Dissertations: **Online** or **in-person**. Both options offer the same end result. How you choose to submit is up to you.

ONLINE SUBMISSION

Electronic submission of your thesis or dissertation is easy and convenient. Go to <http://dissertations.umi.com/hofstra>, click on "submit my dissertation/thesis" and then on "create an account". You will be guided through the steps of submitting your manuscript in PDF format for digital publishing. If you are unable to complete the process in one sitting, you can save your information at any time and continue your submission later.

FAQs as well as publishing guides, instructions on converting your submission to a PDF, and detailed information about each step are included throughout the site. If you wish to consult the FAQs before beginning the process, you can do so at <http://www.etsadmin.com/cgi-bin/main/faq?siteid=19>.

Once your manuscript is submitted, the library will review your submission and contact you. You may log in to your account at <http://dissertations.umi.com/hofstra> any time to see the status of your submission.

Please note: Even if submitting your manuscript electronically, you must still provide the Serials Office with an original copy of your manuscript for the Axinn Library and any copies required by your department for binding. You may also bring personal copies for binding. For more information, call Marie Jones at 516-463-6439. **Do not order bound copies online. All bound copies should be ordered through the Serials Office at Hofstra University.**
