Henry J. Lenowicz (1918-2003) was a private first class in the United States Army. During World War II, he was stationed in Bristol, England, and also served in Luxembourg and France. He was a member of the 509th Military Police Battalion and the 464th and 507th Medical Collection companies.

Henry's mother, Ann, father (name unknown), and sister, Bernice (Bertha) Lenowicz, resided together in New York City. In 1945, while stationed in England, Henry married Ann Arnold, of Bristol.

The collection includes a British Royal Artillery cap badge (brass); correspondence, including letters, postcards, cablegrams and V-mail; foreign currency; newspaper clippings; photographs taken in England and France; German Army postcards illustrated by "Barlog"; and German ration cards.
