The Dr. Jules Richard Block Collection in the Hofstra University Archives consists of the personal and professional papers and publications of Dr. Block, who taught at Hofstra from 1956-1976, and then assumed executive level administrative roles at the University including that of Vice President for Planning an Liaison. He held this position until his retirement in 2001.

The collection includes personal and professional correspondence relating to his roles as professor and administrator at Hofstra, Correspondence relating to his civic duties as a professional at the University and in the community, his research studies and publications, and his inventions and other business endeavors and other media such as cassette tapes, and video cassettes.

Jules Richard Block, the son of Jules Irving and Elizabeth Shinkle Irving, was born in New York City on November 23, 1930. Block received his Bachelor of the Arts degrees in 1952 from Hofstra College. From 1952- 1956 Block, served as a United States Naval Officer. In 1962, Block pursued to get his PH.D. from New York University, he also became a certified New York state Psychologist in the same year.

After returning to civilian life, he began teaching as an instructor at Hofstra in 1956 to 1976. Block than took on a variety of executive level administrative positions at the University, which he climaxed as the Vice President of Planning and Liaison in 1986. Block also held senior positions at other outside organizations such as The Institute for Research and Evaluation, Inc., and The Intial Teaching Alphabet Foundations. He also is a member of The American Psychological Association, The Eastern Psychological Association and is also listed in"Who's Who in America". Currently a professor Emeritus of Psychology at Hofstra University, he was named the 2000 Alumnus of the Year and received the Hofstra University Presidential Medal on May 30, 2001 upon retirement.

Professor Block has written several books, games, studies, and papers throughout his career, some of which have been published. Some of his work includes: *The Towers of Illusion* board games and the books, <u>What's and Illusion? Can You Believe You Eyes</u>, <u>Seeing is Double:</u> <u>Over 200 Mind-Bending Illusions</u>. Block's papers and studies include: "A Scale to Measure Attitudes Toward Disabled Persons", "Disability Types and Behavior Human Resources Study 6", "The Attention Diagnostic Method", "A Self- Administered High School Study of Drugs", and "A Study of Attitudes Toward Controversial Speakers On College Campus."
