Whereas, The estimated cost to Hofstra University in creating and maintaining such a course would be insignificant and immaterial because all resources are already possessed by the University.

Whereas, National surveys show a dramatic increase in the number of students completing a double major.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that it is the finding of the Senate of the Hofstra University Student Government Association that Interdepartmental Honors Essay courses should be offered by the various undergraduate degree granting units of Hofstra University
