

KNOW THE LAWS

SOCIAL HOST LAW

It shall be unlawful for any person over the age of eighteen who owns, rents, or otherwise controls a private residence, to knowingly allow the consumption of alcohol or alcoholic beverages by any minor or to fail to take reasonable corrective action upon learning of the consumption of alcohol or alcoholic beverages by any minor.

BAC = blood alcohol content

DWAI/Alcohol: Driving While Ability Impaired (alcohol); .05 BAC to .07 BAC

\$300-\$500 fine, max 15 day jail, 90 day drivers license suspension

DWI: Driving While Intoxicated; .08 BAC or higher

\$500-\$1000 fine, max 1 year jail, min. 6 months drivers license revocation

Aggravated DWI: Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated: .18 BAC or higher

\$1000-\$2500 fine, max 1 year jail, min. 1 year drivers license revocation

DWAI/Drug: Driving While Ability Impaired by a single Drug other than alcohol.

\$500-\$1000 fine, max 1 year jail, min.6 month drivers license suspension

DWAI/Combination: Driving While Ability Impaired by the Combined Influence of Drugs or Alcohol.

\$500-\$1000 fine, max 1 year jail, min.6 month drivers license revocation

Zero Tolerance: A driver who is less than 21 years of age -.02 BAC to .07 BAC

\$225 fine, 6 month drivers license suspension

Chemical Test Refusal: Over 21—A driver who refuses to take a chemical test

\$500-\$1000 fine, min.1 year drivers license revocation

Chemical Test Refusal: Under 21—A driver who refuses to take a chemical test

\$350 fine, 1 year drivers license revocation
