1. DEADLINE

Applications must be received by **Friday, March 9 at 5:00 p.m.** No applications will be accepted after this day.

2. ELIGIBILITY

If you meet all of the below criteria, you may complete the enclosed application and return it to the Office of Student Activities.

In order to be eligible to apply for Who's Who Among College Students you need to have completed **90 credits** or more as of the start of the Spring 2012 semester. Your G.P.A. needs to be a **2.5** or higher and you should have been involved on the Hofstra University campus.

3. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Please complete the "Who's Who" cover page.
- 2) Complete a **one page essay** (double spaced 10 font Times New Roman) answering the following statement:

Explain why you decided to get involved in co-curricular activities. Describe various projects you have been involved with and what you learned.

4. SUBMIT A RESUME WHICH OUTLINES THE FOLLOWING:

- a. Employment history
- b. Degree pursuing
- c. Campus Involvement
 - i. Community Service
 - ii. Clubs and Organizations
 - iii. Athletics (intramurals, NCAA, or club sports)
 - iv. Professional Affiliations
 - v. Awards/Honors/Scholarships received
- d. Off campus Involvement (Same list as above)

5. If any of the required information is missing the application will be voided.
