Hofstra Welcome Week is a unique and exciting experience both for new and returning students. The Division of Student Affairs works hard to make it a successful welcome week and thank you in advance for your interest in volunteering!

What is Welcome Week?

Welcome Week is 5 days of fun academic programs, trips, guest speakers, and social and educational activities to kick off the academic year. The week is designed to help students, both new and returning, make connections and immerse themselves in campus life. As a leader, you will have the chance to help new students transition to Hofstra, develop leadership skills, and make friends and experiences that will last a lifetime.

What is a Welcome Week Leader?

- *Welcome Week Leader (50-75 students chosen):*
 - o Will lead a group of 15-25 students and will facilitate new students' transition
 - o Perform icebreakers.
 - o Direct students to participate in various Welcome Week Programs
 - o Learn and develop leadership skills that you will have for a lifetime.
- *Welcome Week Move-in Leader (About 40 students)*
 - o Assist with move in and bins on Thursday & Saturday

What is the mandatory time commitment?

Welcome Week 2013 is from Thursday, August 30 to Monday, September 3.

This is a five day commitment! In addition, Welcome Week Leaders must attend training on Tuesday, August 27 and Wednesday, August 28 (Note: Classes begin Tuesday, September 3, 2013).
