

The Hofstra University Career Center's 2009 Education Recruitment Program

Don't Miss out on a Great Job Search Opportunity!

The Education Recruitment Program is a one-day, on-campus interview event, in which both Long Island and New York City school district representatives will be seeking candidates for a variety of certified teaching and counseling-related positions for the 2009-2010 school year. Another feature of this program is a one-day interview event, where out-of-state and upstate New York district representatives interview candidates at a local Long Island university.

To participate in the program, students must be in their FINAL academic year at Hofstra University and receiving state certification to practice in a public school. **This is a benefit of students' FINAL year at Hofstra; December 2008, May 2009 and August 2009 Hofstra graduates are eligible.**

Eligible students must attend one of the **mandatory** Education Recruitment Orientation Sessions listed below, all held at Hofstra's Career Center. Once students attend a session, they are granted access to apply online to a list of participating districts. Districts then select who they want to interview as part of the Hofstra On-Campus Interview Day, scheduled for **Tuesday, March 17, 2009**, or as part of the Out-of-State/Upstate New York Interview Day, scheduled for **Friday, March 13, 2009**.
