frequently asked questions

Q: Am I required to purchase a dining plan?

A: First-year resident students are required to purchase a dining plan. Other students are not required to purchase a dining plan, but with all the benefits, it is strongly recommended.

Q: Who can I speak to if I have dietary restrictions?

A: We have a registered dietician available for one-on-one counseling. For more information, please visit hofstra.edu/askthenutritionist.

Q: Can I change my dining plan?

A: You can make changes to your plan up until the third week of the semester. If you are running low on points, you can add money at any time at My.Hofstra.edu.

Q: Will my unused points carry over from one semester to the next?

A: Points may be carried over from the fall to the spring semester provided that you purchase a plan of equal or higher value for the spring. All points are forfeited the day after spring commencement.

We offer flexible dining plans that help you stay within your budget and save money. All incoming first-year residents are required to purchase dining plan 7, 6 or 5. Other students can take advantage of plans 7 through 2; plan 1 is available for commuting students only. All purchases made with the dining plan are sales tax-free.

Suggested daily usage: \$18

PLAN 6 Provides you with 1,960 points.
Cost per semester: **\$1,960**
Suggested daily usage: \$17

PLAN 5 Provides you with 1,810 points.
Cost per semester: **\$1,810**
Suggested daily usage: \$16

PLAN 4 Provides you with 1,615 points.
Cost per semester: **\$1,615**
Suggested daily usage: \$14

PLAN 3 Provides you with 1,475 points.
Cost per semester: **\$1,475**
Suggested daily usage: \$13

PLAN 2 Provides you with 800 points.
Cost per semester: **\$800**
Suggested daily usage: \$7

PLAN 1 Provides you with 420 points.
Cost per semester: **\$420**

These rates are estimated for the 2012-2013 academic year. The Office of the Bursar/Student Accounts sends fall semester bills to all new students in mid-June that reflect the actual 2012-2013 dining plan rates.
