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Caracost Family Wartime Correspondence, 1941-1946 2.3 c.f.

Macke G. "George" Caracost was a U.S. Naval serviceman from Island Park, L.I., N.Y. During World War II, he did his basic training at the United States Naval Training Station, Great Lakes, Illinois, from mid-March through mid-May 1944. He was then moved to the U.S. Naval Receiving Barracks in Shoemaker, CA, where he was stationed until early June. On June 11, 1944, he arrived at his permanent station, Pearl Harbor, HI, where he served as an aviation machinist's mate. In February 1946, after nearly two years of service at Pearl Harbor, Caracost shipped out to the U.S. Naval Receiving Station at Norfolk, VA. He was discharged from the Navy in April of 1946 at Lido Beach, L.I., N.Y.

The bulk of the collection consists of wartime correspondence (letters, V-mails, postal and greeting cards) to and from Caracost; his sister, Mary; and their parents, Basil and Matilda Caracost, from 1944 through 1945. Correspondents include family members, friends, and fellow servicemen. The collection also includes photographs, news clippings, and general papers.
