The collection includes correspondence (letters, postcards, and a telegram) written in October of 1942 through December of 1942 from Rose Gioffre of Brooklyn, N.Y., to her husband, Vincenzo, who was held in alien internment camps at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, and Fort McAlester, Oklahoma. Rose wrote to her husband and kept in touch with his lawyer on an almost daily basis.
