Jonathan Mulford (1770-1840) Papers, 1799-1843 0.15 cubic ft.

A descendant of the original settlers of the town of East Hampton, New York, Jonathan Mulford (1770-1840) was the son of Colonel David Mulford (1722-1778) and brother of Major David Mulford (1754-1799), both of whom served in the Continental Army.

The collection includes receipts from the estate of Major Mulford, for which Jonathan was the executor, and tuition receipts from Clinton Academy (East Hampton) where Jonathan's children attended school. Also included are business receipts/notes of both Jonathan and his brother David.
