David Litt was born in Poland in 1915, and relocated to the United States with his father, Sol Litwak, in 1923. He graduated from Morris High School in N.Y. in 1934 and became an American Citizen in 1942. He worked as a substitute teacher, tutored students in reading, and also provided piano lessons. He earned a Masters in Fine Arts in 1973 from Brooklyn College. In 1976 he wrote and staged "The Spirit of Raynham Hall," for which he received a letter of appreciation from the Town Board of Oyster Bay. In approximately 1980, he set up the Contemporary Playwright Theater, which produced local plays at the Ethical Humanist Society in Garden City and he later founded the Playwrights Theater Group, which staged his plays and those of other Long Island writers. He died a resident of Woodbury, N.Y., in 2003.
