Alfred Cohn was born on June 7th, 1936. Cohn attended Harvard University and received an A.B. degree in 1958. His career at Hofstra began in 1963, when he became an instructor in the Psychology department. In 1964, Cohn received a Ph.D. from New York University; his thesis was titled "*Behavior with and Attractiveness of a Partner as Functions of Choice and Negative Information.*" He retired from Hofstra in 2004 as a Professor of Psychology, and Teaching Fellow and Adjunct Professor in New College. Dr. Cohn died shortly after his retirement on June 19th, 2004 at age 68.

Roy Udolf was born on August 7th, 1926. He attended New York University and received a B.E.E degree from there in 1950. In 1954, he earned a J.D. degree from Brooklyn Law School, and then in 1963, he earned an M.A. degree from Hofstra University. His career at Hofstra began in 1965 when he became a lecturer in the Psychology department. Udolf went on to earn his Ph.D. in 1971 from Adelphi University. In 2003, he retired from Hofstra as a Professor of Psychology and Teaching Fellow in New College. Roy Udolf died four years later on March 29th, 2007 at 80 years old.
