Historical Note

The Long Island Philharmonic, founded in 1979 by Harry Chapin, Christopher Keene, and Long Island business and community leaders, is the only professional orchestra on Long Island. In its thirty-three year history, it has enriched the Long Island area with both music and music education. Its first music director, Christopher Keene, served from the opening season in 1979 through 1989, followed by Marin Alsop (served 1990-1995), David Lockington (served 1996-2000), and David Wiley, who was appointed in 2001 and serves as music director to this day.

The orchestra performs approximately six concerts per season in both fall and spring, and in recent years has implemented a *Summer in the Parks* concert series, performing free concerts at parks across Long Island in the summer months. The orchestra performs at seven venues across Long Island, its most frequent, or home base, being the Tilles Center for the Performing Arts in Greenvale. Every spring, the orchestra hosts a themed gala, which includes a concert, dinner and a silent auction, to raise funds for the organization. The Philharmonic has a 100-member chorus, also founded in 1979, and an Arts-In-Education initiative, *Music Livz*, designed to bring classical music to students across Long Island through concerts, scholarships, master classes, and an annual Young Artists Competition. It has been named a Primary Arts Organization by the State of New York.

Scope and Content

The Long Island Philharmonic Collection documents the Long Island Philharmonic's history – from its inception in 1979 through 2010 – through both publicity and performance. The collection is comprised of photographs dating back to the Philharmonic's inaugural season; performance and news footage in media of various format, including record reels, audio tapes, digital audio tapes, video tapes, U-matic video tapes, BETA video tapes, CDs, DVDs, and computer discs; and printed materials, including correspondence, press releases, news clippings, mailers, and programs – from both performances and the orchestra's annual galas. The collection provides information on each season's programming, as well as the opportunity to either view or listen to the Philharmonic in action.

The collection is arranged in five series, with the bulk of the collection consisting of an extensive set of photographs of galas, autograph signings, master classes, and performances.

Noteworthy items include record reels of performances by the orchestra during the Keene era, performing works by Beethoven, Strauss, and Sibelius.

The Long Island Philharmonic Collection is arranged in five series:

Series I: Subject Files – contains correspondence, marketing materials, and papers relating to the orchestra's Arts-In-Education initiative. The documents contained in each folder are arranged chronologically.

Series II: Mixed Media – contains advertisements, news footage, and performance footage in audio, video, and computer disc format. Formats are arranged from oldest to newest, starting with record reels and ending with DVDs. The contents of each format are arranged chronologically.

Series III: Programs – the programs distributed to patrons at the Philharmonic's annual gala as well as individual performances. They are arranged chronologically. Gala programs include their respective invitations and auction/seating guides, and are inserted therein. *NOTE: not all gala years have corresponding invitations, but all include auction/seating guides.*

Series IV: Publicity – includes documents advertising the Philharmonic's history and are arranged chronologically. They are arranged in 3 groups: press clippings, press releases, and marketing materials. Marketing materials are mailers that advertised the season's programming and artists, distributed to the public.

Series V: Photographs are arranged chronologically and grouped by event, such as a performance, gala, master class, or autograph signing. This is followed by the negatives of those photographs, arranged chronologically. Next are photographs on CD. *NOTE: Not all photographs have corresponding negatives or CDs, and vice-versa.* There are also slides arranged chronologically.
