Radin, Paul (1883 – 1959) Collection, 1914 -1959

Paul Radin, an anthropologist, was born in Lodz, Poland, to Adolf and Joana Radin.¹ In 1884, his family immigrated to the United States and settled in Elmira, New York, before finally moving to New York City in 1890.² He attended City College, New York, and received his bachelors degree in 1902.³ He enrolled in Columbia University to pursue graduate studies in zoology but departed to Europe in 1905 and studied anthropology instead.⁴ After spending two years in Europe, he returned to Columbia where, under the guidance of Franz Boas, he obtained his Ph.D. in anthropology in 1911. There, he met other students such as Sapir, Lowie and Speck who later became his colleagues.

As an ethnologist, Radin's scholarly pursuits were primarily focused on the study of North American Indian tribes, such as the Winnebago and the Ojibwa. His approach to the study of culture emphasized the individual, focusing on myth as the key to understanding the religious and historical contexts of man's civilization.⁵ To this end, he wrote several books and journal articles on various topics about these tribes. Interestingly, as a distinguished linguist, his body of work was not limited to expression in the English language. Radin also published in foreign languages such as French, Spanish and German. Examples of such publications are included in this collection.

Radin had a mobile academic lifestyle. Thus, at one time or another in his professional career he was affiliated with institutions such as Harvard, Columbia, Berkeley, Michigan, Brandeis, Kenyon College, Cambridge, Oxford, Manchester, and the Geological Survey of Canada. He also lectured at the Erasnos conferences in Ascona, and the C.G. Institut in Zurich, both in Switzerland.

This collection features some of Radin's publications including books and scholarly articles. Among the books in the collection are *Primitive Religion: Its Nature and Origin* published in both English and French, *The World of Primitive Man* and *The Story of the American Indian*. In addition, the collection includes reprints of journal articles Radin wrote such as “*The Autobiography of a Winnebago Indian*,” “*Religion of the North American Indians*” and “*Some Myths and Tales of the Ojibwa of Southeastern Ontario*.” Other journal articles in the collection include those Radin received from some of his contemporaries such as Lowie and Sapir; some are personally signed.

A handwritten manuscript of the book *The Racial Myth* is included in the collection as well as a personal notebook containing notes entirely on religion. In addition, a speech or a lecture titled “*What is Anthropology?*” in Radin’s handwriting is found in the research folio, *The Subject Matter of Anthropology and Ethnology*. Other research folios containing materials on various topics such as *Anthropological Investigation of the Eskimo*, *Anthropological Investigation Concerning South and Central American Indians*, and *Scandinavian Studies*, form part of the collection.

The collection contains foreign language materials on items which may have been of intellectual interest to Radin. Notably, works by Rafael Dávila on Mexican socio-political life, and others by Josef Joaquin Fernandez de Lizardi, written under the pseudonym of El Pensador Mexicano, are included in the collection. Published works by unknown authors (possibly from Ahmedabad, India) and written either in Gujarati or Sanskrit texts, are also included.

Finally, the collection contains pamphlets from the Sutro Library Collection Reprint Series that feature English and Mexican works created under Radin’s supervision as part of the Works Progress Administration during the New Deal.
