World's Fairs Collection, 1893-1965 2.9 cu. ft.

The collection contains materials related to the World's Fairs held in Chicago, Illinois (1893 and 1933-1934); Buffalo, New York (1901); St. Louis, Missouri (1904); Queens, New York (1939-1940 and 1964-1965); and Montreal, Canada (1967). Included are business records, DVDs, ephemera, maps, memorabilia, news clippings, newspapers, postcards, printed materials, and publications.

Noteworthy items include a souvenir postcard of the Electricity Building at the 1893 Chicago World's Fair, and a number of guides and maps to the New York World's Fairs of 1939-1940 and 1964-1965.
