## **Guidelines for Attendance Modification Accommodations**

## Requests for attendance related accommodation should be considered using the following criteria:

- 1. Is the request reasonable in the context of the course and the program of study?
- 2. Is there classroom interaction between the professor and the students and among students themselves?
- 3. Do student contributions in class constitute a significant component of the learning process?
- 4. Does the fundamental nature of the course rely upon student participation as an essential method of learning?
- 5. To what degree does a student's failure to attend class constitute a significant loss of the educational experience of other students in the class?
- 6. What does the course description and syllabus say about attendance?
- 7. What is the method by which the final course grade is calculated?
- 8. Is there a legitimate alternative accommodation that can be made instead of modifying attendance requirements?

## All contractual agreements regarding expectations for class attendance should be written out and signed by both students and faculty and should include:

- 1. Student responsibilities when unexpected absences related to the disability occur
- 2. Faculty responsibilities when unexpected absences occur
- 3. Method for completion of missed work when absences occur
- 4. The number of absences allowed by the accommodation
