## A Resolution to Rectify Academic Inequities within Grading

*Whereas*, the Student Government Association, henceforth referred to as SGA, has been made aware of many instances in which students' grades are not posted or updated regularly leading students to not be able to thrive academically;

Whereas, SGA recognizes students are unable to thrive in an academic environment without up to date information on their grades;

Whereas, Students are unable to know if they require additional help in their classes without receiving grades in a timely manner;

Whereas, SGA believes that the student body has the right to understand their overall grade in a class before the last day to withdraw, as well as before major exams;

*Let it be resolved*, SGA calls upon the Provost united with the American Association of University Professors at Hofstra to develop a fair and reasonable standard of when grades should be returned to students:

Let it be further resolved, SGA calls for the faculty policy series to be amended so that professors are required to include this time-table in their syllabus;

Let it be further resolved. The university will see to it that a student's grade in their classes is accessible to them at any time during the semester should they request to view it.
