

Music Department Requirements for Private Instruction and Juries

B.S. in Performance

- 4 semesters of P-level lessons
- 2 semesters of C-level lessons
- 2 semesters of D-level lessons

B.S. in Music Theory/Composition

- 2 semesters of P-level lessons on an instrument or voice
- 2 semesters of P-level lessons in composition
- 2 semesters of B-level lessons (Intermediate Composition lessons)
- 2 semesters of D-level lessons (Advanced Composition lessons, including a recital)

B.S. in Music Education

- 6 semesters of P-level lessons, or
- 4 semesters of P-level lessons plus 2 semesters of C-level lessons

B.S. in Jazz & Commercial Music

- 4 semesters of P-level lessons
- 2 semesters of C-level lessons

B.S. in Music History & Literature

4 semesters of P-level lessons

B.S. in Music Business

4 semesters of P-level lessons

B.A. in Music

4 semesters of P-level lessons

B.A. in Music Business

No lesson requirement

Jury Requirements

A jury is required at the end of each semester of private instruction, with the following exceptions:

- First semester of private instruction; transfer students should consult the Private Instructor
- Any semester in which a C-level, D-level or Honors recital is performed (at the discretion of the Private Instructor)
- At the discretion of the Private Instructor, a jury can be waived and replaced with an alternative final assignment
- Students pursuing the BA in Music degree must perform a classical work and is allowed to perform a piece in another genre as approved by the Private Instructor
