 - i. I am Brit, I am the Title IX supervisor and I wanted to come here specifically this month as April is sexual assault month. I am open to meeting with all students and can be reached in my office, on email or over the phone. I also have a calendly link that is always live.
 - 1. Senator Tauro: In terms of what students can do, what resources are there for students to help others that may have an issue with sexual assault?
 - a. If you are ever aware of something that has happened, you can come directly to me, you can email the title ix email, or you can use the link on the HOfstra website. After this is filed, I will do some outreach to the person affected and we go over accommodations and what can be done to support the student. Friends are also allowed to come either to support their friends, or to talk one on one with me to discuss how to talk about the situation and how you can help or even if the

- situation is affecting you even if it is not directly harmful to you.
- 2. Chair Atlas: How can SGA grow to foster our relationship with your office and
 - a. Having students voices on our committee is amazing and posting our flyers if you are not on the committee. If there are concerns being raised that are general, please bring those forward to me so we can begin to have this conversation and grow in how we support each other and the student body.
- 3. Comptroller Fountain: This is more specific to my role as an RA. If there is no contact between students and they feel like there needs to be something else put into place, what should they do?
 - a. I think the best option would be to come to me and we can discuss the logistics and options. We can always discuss next steps and what can and cannot be done
- 4. Chair Pandit: What initiatives have you done on Campus and out of those what is the most meaningful?
 - a. We had Love, Sex, adn Friendship weeks. We have the safe center tabling in the atrium, we have denim day, take back the night, and more tabling events. We are trying to push awareness and I am hoping to start an Active Minds chapter on Hofstra. All of these are very meaningful but I really do love having the feedback from the students.
- 5. Chair Stadeker: There is an individual on campus with multiple title IX infractions, and we were wondering what happens when they do have multiple infractions and what is done?
 - a. It really does depend. What folks think can be very different from the truth and it is really dependent on what the reporting individual wants to have happen. The university does have an obligation to conduct an investigation when needed but it is again very dependent on the situation.
- 6. Chair Stadeker: Does the Title IX office monitor social media or apps to see if infractions are occurring?

- a. The office does not monitor social media but social media, and screenshots can be sent in. Since a lot of these apps have anonymous features it can be challenging to find who it is or how to approach the situation.
- 7. Chair Stadeker: Where can students access crime statistics for Hofstra?
 - a. It is on the Public Safety website. The campus climate survey is also a way we collect data.
- 8. Vice President Singh: As we start to reach the end of our year, what can we look forward to and help support?
 - a. I am working on having particular training to be offered as well as basic Title IX training. I am building a consent workshop and bystander intervention. We also want to transform our website to be less text heavy.
- 9. Associate Bell: In regards to associates, how can we spread the message?
 - a. If there is anything you can do with elements of wellness or awareness, I would love to partner with you to give perspective. I am happy to share my skills and knowledge in this area. I would say to continue encouraging students to be actively learning, becoming more comfortable with reporting and talking to me, and reducing the stigma.
