      - a. Senator Egolf: Do you know how many hours of rink time that they currently have and what they would have with 75% of their budget?
        - i. Chair Giovanangelo: They would have 23 hours of practice at 50% and to go up to 75%, it would add an additional 7 to 8 hours.

- ii. Comptroller Fountain: For reference, the second highest club got half of what they currently have. Their club has a large amount of income that could possibly cover all these costs. If we fully funded this we would be over what SGA can properly fund. There are multiple factors we took into consideration, but we also had a reason to cap it due to all the clubs on campus.
- iii. Chair Stadeker: I do not know if they do pay a fee but in the majority of the club sports I have participated in, I have had to give money towards the club.
- iv. Senator Barone: There were a lot of issues, but we were good this semester with saving money. I recommended not going above 25000, just because they got a lot more than other clubs.
- v. Senator Egolf: Can you clarify what you mean by a club's income?
  - 1. Comptroller Fountain: Income is something that we have no control over, it never goes away or rolls back like SGA funds. And a club can use it on whatever they want.
- vi. Senator Egolf: In their own income, do you have all if not close to the money they need in income?
  - 1. Comptroller Fountain: I can not say an exact number but it is close.
- vii. Chair Atlas: What would it be if we funded 60% of the budget?
  - 1. Chair Giovangelo: It would be an additional \$3,188.09 for 60%.
- viii. Senator Greenlaw: It's a lot of money and it was more than we originally wanted to allocate. That took away opportunities for other clubs.
- ix. Comptroller Fountain: My recommendation is to keep it at this.

- x. Comptroller Fountain: Like previous speakers mentioned, we spent hours talking about these budgets. My recommendation is to keep it at this and have some of the largest amount allocated compared to other clubs.
- xi. Chair Stadeker: They have income to cover it so I would be alright with this. I think getting them more money would be harmful to other clubs in the long-run who want to do events.
- xii. Chair Giovanangelo: I know some seem skeptical about giving them money. They can always come back for money and ask for extra money and we would maybe have a better gauge of what would be the best amount. It's not an end all be all.
- xiii. Comptroller Fountain: There are still a lot of clubs that didn't ask for money or get a full budget, and clubs who put on events that a lot of students enjoy.
- xiv. Chair Atlas: Has this club marked any reservations over using their income?
  1. Comptroller Fountain: They have spent some of it but we are not in charge of it at all so it
- xv. Senator Egolf: With the way the contracts work, do they have to pay now or can they add later?
  1. Comptroller Fountain: The contract is for very specific dates, they can ask for more or less games but that was what they asked for.
- xvi. Chair Pandit: What would 55% look like?

1. Chair Giovanangelo: 55% would be \$1617.20 and it would be an additional game and practice hour.

We are 57% of all clubs that have gotten money, and we want to see how clubs will use this money and if it is needed.
