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


### The world is a physical machine

#### Lucretius (48 BCE)


- 1. Nothing comes from nothing
- 2. Nothing is ever completely destroyed
- 3. Ordinary things like kings and cabbages are created and destroyed all the time
- 4. Therefore ordinary things, and the entire world, are made of indestructible "atoms"


"Observe what happens when sunbeams are admitted into a building and shed light on its shadowy places. You will see a multitude of tiny particles mingling in a multitude of ways... their dancing is an actual indication of underlying movements of matter that are hidden from our sight"



#### Einstein (1906)

- 1. Math: how Brownian motion relates to size of particles
- 2. Physics: measure Brownian motion
- 3. Calculate: the size of the atoms in this configuration


