STEM/STEAM: Introduction to Software Development – Python / Grades 9-12

Students gain an understanding of the basics of programming: how to create, test, and build their own programs; and how to use coding to help them in everyday life. Python is widely used in industry by companies such as Google and is a great language for students to develop programs to help with everyday tasks and homework, and to build their own games. Students are encouraged to bring a pen/pencil as well as a notebook to each class.

Scratch: Introduction to Coding / Grades 2-4

Time: 9-10:25 a.m. Tuition: \$175 / 6 sessions

Students learn basic programming logic, improve math skills, and create games and activities using Scratch. Programming with Scratch offers students of all ages a fun and meaningful introduction to programming. Students learn to program games and activities by snapping together code blocks instead of writing many lines of code. Scratch's puzzle-like design prevents young coders from getting frustrated with errors related to abstract concepts such as programming syntax and semantics. Furthermore, Scratch allows students to learn programming in a hands-on environment in order to gain the knowledge and skills needed to succeed in learning traditional programming languages such as Python, Java, and C++.

Course Requirements: Each student must have a workstation (desktop computer, laptop, Chromebook) and a separate device (i.e., smartphone) to join via Zoom.
