REACH Program

This support service allows campers with disabilities who enroll in any Hofstra Day Camp program to experience camp activities alongside their peers. Campers enrolled in the program receive a one-on-one buddy who works in our volunteer program.

A DAY IN THE LIFE: Traditional Camp Experience

Hofstra Day Camp is the heart of our camp community, where campers shape their experience by choosing a specific program each session. Alongside their chosen program, they enjoy a variety of activities and also attend a special event once a week, including carnivals, magicians, concerts, and much more!

Campers in grades 2-5 spend the morning in their selected program and the afternoon participating in different camp activities. Alternatively, campers in grades 6-10 participate in camp activities in the morning, followed by their program of choice in the afternoon.

For campers entering kindergarten or first grade, our Cub Camp offers a well-rounded, traditional camp experience. Cubbies enjoy activities in movement, creative arts, organized sports, water play, and lunch. Our young campers join in for all of the entertainment and special events as part of the Hofstra Day Camp experience.

Sports Academy Camps

As part of the Hofstra University community, our athletic campers benefit from access to Division 1 coaches, players, and top-notch indoor and outdoor facilities, including stadiums, arenas, and practice areas.

Campers in these programs enjoy a full day of their selected sports with a tailored schedule designed to enhance their skills.

Sports Academy Camps are open to all entrants (limited only by number, age, grade, and/or gender).



Creatively inclined campers have exciting new opportunities to express themselves through programming at the Long Island High School for the Arts (LIHSA). These full-day, conservatory-style programs give middle and high school campers the chance to explore fine arts, studio work, visual arts, musical theater, costume design, and sound production. These programs take place at LIHSA's state-of-the-art facility in Syosset.


Nassau BOCES

Campers can explore various technical and career programming through our partnership with BOCES. Middle and high school campers can dive into mechanical and automotive studies, carpentry, culinary arts, or even explore the natural beauty of Long Island's coastline. All of these programs are full-day, hands-on experiences that take place at either Nassau BOCES Barry Tech, Caumsett State Historic Park Preserve, or the Brookville Outdoor and Environmental Education Center.

Lunch

All lunches are prepared and served buffet style by Hofstra University's on-site premier dining partner, Compass Group. Our rotating menu includes a well-balanced hot entree, beverage, and dessert

every day. For campers who prefer alternatives to the daily menu, salads, bagels, and sandwiches are available.

Please note that Hofstra Summer Camps is peanutaware, and allergen-free meals are available for campers with specific dietary needs.



Transportation

Transportation is included in the cost of all Hofstra Summer Camps, with the exception of those enrolled in LIHSA and the Sports Academy Camps. Transportation is available as an add-on for our Sports Academy Camps.



Medical Staff

Hofstra Summer Camps proudly offers a fully staffed Wellness Center throughout the camp season. Campers receive compassionate and professional care for everything from minor injuries to

more significant medical needs. Our team includes registered nurses and emergency medical technicians who are centrally located in our Student Health Center and stationed across our indoor and outdoor facilities for timely care.



Public Safety

Hofstra's Department of Public Safety is dedicated to ensuring the safety and security of our campers throughout the duration of the camp day. Hofstra Summer Camps is assigned two officers who exclusively

provide an additional layer of support to our camp community.

Summer Schedule

Hofstra Summer Camps operates over a seven-week period. Most of our programming consists of two-week sessions, except for Session 4 programs and our Sports Academy Camps, which run for one week at a time. Therefore, campers can stay for as little as one week – or for all seven – depending on their schedule and their interests. Camp operating hours are 9 a.m.-4 p.m., Monday through Friday, and our office is open 7 a.m.-6 p.m. during the summer.

Rates and Discounts

Tuition for many of our programs includes lunch and transportation, unless otherwise noted. Sports Academy Camps do not include transportation but can be added for an additional fee. Makerspace Experience and Extended Hours can be added for additional fees as well.
