ABSTRACT: This study examined whether food insecurity predictors were different in the general population compared to individuals with hospital discharges, and also whether food-insecure hospital patients differed from food-insecure community members. Food insecurity predictors differed between the general population and individuals with hospital discharges; food-insecure individuals with and without hospital discharges also differed statistically. Therefore, hospitals should carefully consider their target populations when constructing population health initiatives
