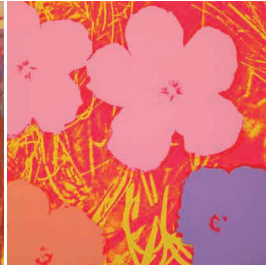

- Open year-round to the public with free admission.
- Comprises two wheelchair-accessible galleries, Emily Lowe Gallery located behind Emily Lowe Hall, and David Filderman Gallery located on the ninth floor of the Joan and Donald E. Axinn Library.
- Has an extensive outdoor sculpture collection throughout Hofstra's 240-acre campus with works by internationally renowned artists such as Henry Moore and Seymour Lipton.

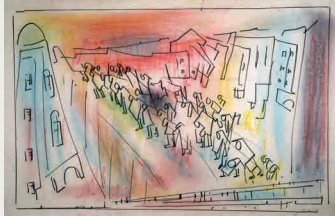


Core Membership Benefits (Individual) – \$35

Friend Level \$500-\$999

Patron Level – \$1,000 and above

This level includes all of the benefits of the Sustainer level and **also provides for partial underwriting of select exhibitions**. Donor recognition is included in all related exhibition publications, press releases, and other related exhibition marketing.

*Must provide current and valid identification. For the Supporter Level, \$115 is tax deductible. For the Sustainer Level, \$265 is tax deductible. For the Friend Level, all but \$55 is tax deductible. For the Patron Level all but \$295 is tax deductible.
