John Rawlinson

Dr John L. Rawlinson, Professor Emeritus of History, who taught in Hofstra University's History Department from 1955-1992, passed away on May 19, 2009. He served as chairman of the Senate Executive Committee and was the founder of the Hofstra Social Science Associum.
