### Middle Childhood Extension: Grades 5-6

Persons holding or completing the New York State Certificate in grades 7-12 can earn a Certificate for Middle Childhood Extension into grades 5-6 by *completing* SED/CT 221 (3 s.h.); CT 247A (3 s.h.); electives (6 s.h.), including a literacy-related course; and certification exams, if needed (elective hours not required if completing *initial* certification).

### Middle Childhood Extension: Grades 7-9

Persons holding or completing the New York State Certificate for Pre K-6 can earn a Certificate for Middle Childhood Extension for grades 7-9 by *completing* SED/CT 221 (3 s.h.); CT 248A (3 s.h.); and providing evidence of having *completed specialization requirements* at the undergraduate or graduate level in a language other than English, mathematics, social studies, biology, chemistry, geology or physics; and certification exams, if needed.

### Middle Childhood Philosophy and Teaching. SED/CT 221 (3 s.h.) or non-credit option.

Persons who wish to take the first week only can enroll, as well as those continuing the middle level sequence. This graduate course counts as an elective in the secondary education master's degree program.

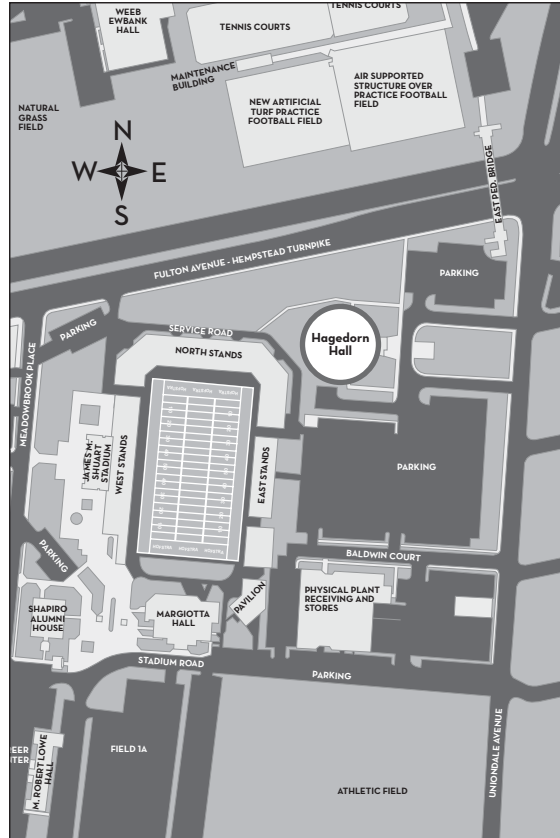
