A resolution to show support for the Club Constitution Guidelines drafted by the Rules Committee of the Student Government Association

- Whereas, the Rules Committee of the Student Government Association has been working to create a more responsible club creation process;
- Whereas, precedent has dictated that potential new clubs are given a blank constitution to be filled out, which is neither comprehensive nor consistent with every club's purpose;
- Whereas, the previous sample constitution is outdated, poorly written, and clerically incorrect;
- Let it be resolved, that the Hofstra University Student Government Association accepts the Club Constitution Guidelines drafted by the Rules Committee as a resource for all clubs and organizations either governed by the Student Government Association or in the process of becoming recognized by the Student Government Association.
- Let it be further resolved, that the Student Government Association will recommend these guidelines be used for potential new clubs and organizations that wish to become recognized by Hofstra University and not by the Student Government Association.
