

Stephen B. Carlin/Walter W. Rudolph Endowed Memorial Scholarship 2023-2024

Dear Applicant:

The Stephen B. Carlin/Walter W. Rudolph Endowed Memorial Scholarship was established in 1986 by family and friends of Hofstra alumni Stephen Carlin and Walter Rudolph who made the ultimate sacrifice in Vietnam. Those senior high school students who have been accepted to Hofstra University and meet the following requirements are eligible to apply:

- The applicant is a direct descendent of an honorably-discharged "in country" Vietnam War veteran of the U.S. Military Services, or
- The applicant is, or is the direct descendent of, an honorably discharged veteran of the U.S Military Services with "in-country" service in Afghanistan or Iraq since 1991, or
- The applicant is, or is a direct descendent of, an honorably-discharged veteran of the U.S. Military Services, and
- The applicant has demonstrated outstanding academic, co-curricular and community involvement, and/or financial need.

Scholarships are awarded to one or more matriculated students at Hofstra University. Recipients must remain in good standing while at the University. This scholarship is awarded by the Hofstra University Office of Financial Aid upon the recommendation of the Carlin/Rudolph Scholarship Committee.

For consideration, the applicant must already be admitted to Hofstra University, and submit a completed application which includes the following items:

1) A copy of your current high school or college transcript, or if current Hofstra student, a copy of your DAR/DegreeWorks report. *These should be web (NOT official) transcripts*; 2) FERPA Student Release consent form; 3) Form DD214 (for the applicant or the applicant's Veteran relative); and 4) typed Personal Statement.

The **FERPA Student Release consent form must be submitted with this application**. This form pertains to this application only and can be obtained from the Student Financial Services and Registrar Suite in Memorial Hall, or downloaded from: www.hofstra.edu/pdf/acadrec_FERPA.pdf. On this form, fill in Name of Authorized Person: *Carlin/Rudolph Scholarship Committee*.
