**Master of Public Health Program**  
**Opportunity for Third-Party Comment**

The Hofstra University Master of Public Health (MPH) Program is scheduled for re-accreditation review, with a site visit scheduled for January 31, 2022-February 1, 2022. As part of the re-accreditation review and site visit, the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH) has a procedure for third-party comments that assures an opportunity for the program's stakeholders, including students, alumni, faculty, employers, advisory board members, and community partners, to provide written comments to CEPH until 30 days before the scheduled site visit.

This process is separate from the program's systematic process of obtaining feedback from stakeholders on the self-study document, is broader, and is intended to allow all program stakeholders to provide feedback directly to CEPH that will inform their accreditation review. Students, alumni, faculty, staff, community partners and members of the general public are all stakeholders who may make a third-party comment during this process.

Individuals who wish to provide such input may do so by providing comments to CEPH until **Jan 1, 2022**. Comments from third-parties will be accepted by CEPH until 30 days before the scheduled site visit.
