I acknowledge that if I do not pay the full amount due under this dining contract, or any other amount due on my student account, I will be responsible for all costs and expenses associated with the collection of such unpaid amounts. This includes the fees of any collections agency, which may be based on a percentage of the total balance due (up to a maximum of 45% of the total balance due) and reasonable attorney's fees. Student-athletes are advised to discuss dining plan changes with their athletic administrator or financial aid counselor, as the student is ultimately responsible for any additional costs associated with the dining plan.
