





2022 Music Education Programs at Hofstra University AOSA Endorsed Orff-Schulwerk Teacher Education and FAME Endorsed Feierabend Courses

Enrollment Eligibility:

Any student who currently holds a bachelor's degree and is involved in the field of music is encouraged to register for these courses.

Credit:

Students may register to receive either three graduate credits for each course or take the course for non-credit. Many school districts award "In-Service credits" or "Professional Development (PD) hours" to employees who successfully complete these non-credit courses. A certificate of completion is awarded to all credit and non-credit students upon successful completion of the course requirements. Participants should carefully consider whether to register for the graduate credit section or to enroll as a non-credit student. Those students wishing to enroll in the graduate credit section must be admitted as a matriculated or non matriculated graduate student and are held to the published tuition fee schedule for all graduate students.

Tuition and Fees:

<u>Graduate credit students</u>: Tuition is \$1510 per graduate credit. The courses are three graduate credits each. Graduate credit students must also pay \$133 in University fees.

<u>Non-credit students</u>: The workshop fee is \$700 per course. The Orff-Schulwerk Teacher Education Levels courses are available for 60 Professional Development hours. The First Steps in Music, Conversational Solfege and First Steps with Orff Schulwerk courses are available for 45 Professional Development hours.

Admission

Non-Hofstra students must submit an online application for non matriculated graduate study through the Office of Graduate Admission at hofstra.edu/nonmatric. This form should be used regardless of whether you are seeking Graduate Credit or In-Service Credit. The application requires a bachelor's or master's degree transcript be uploaded (unofficial copies are sufficient). Hofstra students may register online through their portal.

COVID-19 Vaccination

Please note that <u>all students and faculty must be fully vaccinated to enroll in a course at Hofstra University.</u> After applying online, you will be asked to upload a copy of your proof of vaccination.

Registration and Payment:

The Office of Graduate Admission will assist admitted students with registering for coursework. If you must withdraw your registration, you must provide your intent to do so in writing to graduateadmission@hofstra.edu.

Following registration, a complete invoice will be available to you online in your Hofstra Student Portal. All payments should be made directly through your Hofstra Portal according to the payment deadlines at hofstra.edu/academiccalendar. You may pay by Credit Card or electronic check. Credit Card transactions are subject to a 2.85% processing fee. For those wishing to pay with Cash, you will need to schedule an appointment with Student Financial Services.
